WATCHING ADVENTURE CRUISE**

DATE: Friday, October 4, 2019 (No Rain Date)

PLACE: Meet at the Riis Landing Boat Basin in Breezy Point, Queens by no later than 11:30 AM to board the vessel "*American Princess*" for a four (4) hour whale watching adventure through the Lower New York Bay.

Trip will include narration by a staff member of the New York Aquarium. Additionally, it has a full galley on board, inclusive of a cash bar, where lunch & beverages may be optionally purchased (**Coolers are not permitted on board**). Ship will depart promptly at 12:00 noon and will return to the dock by approximately 4 PM.
